

## SOUTH UMPQUA MASONIC LODGE #72 A.F. & A.M. SCHOLARSHIP POLICY STATEMENT

### Requirements:

1. The South Umpqua Masonic Lodge #72 A.F. & A.M. will award scholarships in the amount of at least \$1000 each.

One \$1000 scholarship will be presented to a graduating senior at Days Creek Charter School.

One \$1000 scholarship will be presented to a graduating senior at South Umpqua High School.

One \$1000 scholarship will be presented to a graduating senior at Riddle High School

Scholarships in the amount of at least \$1000 will be made available to children or grandchildren of South Umpqua Masonic Lodge #72 A.F. & A. M. members. The child or grandchild can be either a graduating senior or an already enrolled college student.

The scholarships are to be used at an accredited higher education institution. The accredited school may be a technical school, a two-year college, or a four-year college. The higher education institution may be in the state of Oregon or out-of-state. After notification of registration from the recipient, a check will be mailed directly to the Financial Aid Office of the school attending. If the recipient does not enroll at a school for the Fall quarter or semester, the recipient has until the following Fall Term (1 year) to utilize the scholarship. In such a case, it is the recipient's responsibility to make a written request to the South Umpqua Masonic Lodge detailing his/her intentions for using the scholarship by the beginning of this year's Fall Term. If the recipient does not use the scholarship, and a written request for holding the money for one year is not made, an alternate will be awarded the funds.

Past recipients are eligible to reapply each year for a scholarship.

2. A minimum GPA of 2.5 is required to apply. Emphasis for selection will be placed on academic standing, financial need, and initiative.
3. Applicants that are related to a Masonic member will be given priority in the selection process.
4. All materials submitted shall be typed.
5. Applicants may be requested to appear for an interview.
6. The deadline for receiving scholarship applications is April 15. Applications **received** after that date will not be considered.
